CoCA is programmed by a voluntary group of Waitaha-based art practitioners with expertise in contemporary art, visual art and arts education. The Programming Group is seeking expressions of interest from local artists / arts practitioners who are keen to be involved.

The Programming Group works collaboratively with Board members and staff to support CoCA's exhibition programme. This is an active group that helps shape the vision of the gallery through selecting exhibitions (for projects in and out of the gallery) and guiding public programmes. You will help CoCA build partnerships with arts organisations and local tertiary arts providers and start new initiatives such as the Emerging Curator Programme.

Involvement in the CoCA Programming Group:

- Attend four group meetings per year (every 3-months)
- Assess applications made to CoCA's annual Open Call for Proposals
- Advocate for local artists and supporting the gallery
- Support development of programming and facilitation of exhibitions.
- Minimum 1-year commitment

Being part of the Programming Group is a great way to meaningfully contribute to the Ōtautahi arts community. You'll be part of an energetic and committed group of people who are passionate about supporting artists and contemporary art through CoCA's programmes and exhibitions.

During the 2026 callout for new Programming Group members, we are particularly interested to hear from artists with experience in performance, sound, and/or moving image, and from emerging artists.
